Course Content

The 4-day blended programme (practical + classroom) will cover:

- Safeguarding for coaching children in sport
- Garda vetting procedures (mandatory for all coaches)
- Anti-doping awareness for coaches
- Coaching techniques & applied fundamentals
- Introduction to First aid
- Practical mat-based wrestling coaching skills

By the end, participants will have the **skills and confidence** to deliver safe, high-quality training sessions in their clubs.

This is a **coaching development course**, not a wrestling drills seminar. The focus is on helping coaches and trainers expand their knowledge, refine methods and strengthen their ability to teach athletes. Participants will learn practical strategies, coaching techniques and effective approaches to development, skills that go beyond running drills. This course is designed to elevate the way you coach, improve the way you communicate, and ultimately make you a more impactful in your sport.

Pre-Requisites

- 1. IAWA Membership 2025/26 (must be valid)
- 2. IAWA Garda Vetting (free):
 - o Forms must be submitted before Weekend 1.
 - o Certificates will only be awarded once clearance is confirmed.

- 3. UWW Online Certificate (Free):
 - Complete the *Ready to Wrestle* eLearning course at <u>academy.uww.org</u>
 The United World Wrestling Academy is an integrated online learning portal designed to provide information, tools and resources in order to support and enhance the knowledge and value of the discipline of wrestling. You must set up your own profile on the UWW website at <u>Academy | United World Wrestling | Academy platform of United World Wrestling</u>. If English is not your first language, no problem, you can choose the language that you are most familiar with.
