The IAWA are now taking expressions of interest from participants, Male and Female, to represent Irish Wrestling in the British Junior Freestyle Championships 2023.

Competition Name – British Junior Championships 2023

Competition Date – Saturday 13th May 2023,

Closing date for registration 29th April 2023 (Places are limited and this is subject to change depending on numbers)

Weigh in – Morning Weigh in U9, U11, U13 0800 - 09.00

Afternoon Weigh in U15, U17, U20 1215-1315

Competition wear must be worn at the weigh in.

Style – Freestyle Male and Womens Wrestling (WW),

Ages - U9, U11, U13, U15, U17, U20

Weight Categories Freestyle Male and Women's Wrestling

U20 FS Male: 57kg, 61kg, 65kg, 70kg, 74kg, 79kg, 86kg, 92kg, 97kg, 125kg

U20 WW: 50 kg 53 kg, 55 kg, 57 kg, 59 kg, 62 kg, 65kg, 68kg, 72kg, 76 kg

U17 FS Male: 41-45kg, 48kg, 51kg, 55kg, 60kg, 65kg, 71kg, 80kg, 92kg, 110kg

U17 WW: 36-40kg, 43kg, 46kg, 49kg, 53kg, 57kg, 61kg, 65kg, 69kg, 73 kg

U15, U13, U11, U9 Age groups will be matched on the day based on 10% of weight in accordance with British Wrestling Guidelines.

U9 and U11 females will be paired with males where a female only group is not possible.

Missing weight will mean forfeit from the tournament without refund or costs covered.

Cost – The IAWA will cover the competition fee and a percentage of the travel cost for suitable wrestlers and IAWA coaches only. This will be reimbursed after the competition and is subject to terms and conditions. Wrestlers and coaches are responsible for making their own way to and from the competition.

Criteria for entry – Wrestlers under 18 must travel with a parent or adult guardian. The IAWA do not book flights or accommodation. All wrestlers must have a registered & Vetted IAWA Coach. All Participants must be a current IAWA members and must hold a current passport to travel to the UK (Any nation) with at least 6 months validity after the date of the competition. They must also have an appropriate visa if required by you to travel to the UK. Entries for this

competition must go through the IAWA. Participants must be of a reasonable standard of wrestling ability. Wrestling ability must be verified by an IAWA Coach. Participants must be medically fit to wrestle.

Wrestlers and Coaches are reminded that when travelling abroad they are representing Ireland and Irish Wrestling. The only thing that is asked for in return for sponsoring wrestlers travelling to compete in these events, is that they do their best and if they are lucky enough to make it onto the podium for a medal that they wear Irish Wrestling apparel such as an IAWA branded T-shirt, hoodie or singlet. When the IAWA invest in wrestlers travelling to represent Irish wrestling, it is only fair that it gets recognised publicly.
