## **British Senior Championships 2023**

The IAWA are now taking expressions of interest from participants, Male and Female, to represent Irish Wrestling in the British Junior Freestyle Championships 2023.

**Competition Name** – British Senior Championships 2023

**Competition Date** – This is a TWO DAY Competition

**Saturday** 10<sup>th</sup> and **Sunday** 11<sup>th</sup> June 2023,

Closing date for registration 26<sup>th</sup> May. Closing date may change depending on entries being full sooner.

**Weigh in** – Singlets must be worn at the weigh in.

**Style** – Freestyle Male (FS) and Womens Wrestling (WW), Greco Roman (GR)

**Venue** – Wright Robinson College, Abbey Hey Lane, Gorton Manchester M18 8RL

**Ages - Seniors**, Any person born 2003 or earlier. Wrestlers aged 18 years and older can participate in this event with permission.

**GR:** 55/63/72/82kgs

**Veterans:** All divisions “A” through to “E” 55-62/70/78/88/100/100-130kgs

**Missing weight will mean forfeit from the tournament without refund or costs covered.**

**Cost** – The IAWA will cover the competition fee and a percentage of the travel cost for suitable wrestlers and IAWA coaches only. This will be reimbursed after the competition and is subject to terms and conditions. Wrestlers and coaches are responsible for making their own way to and from the competition venue and accommodation.

**Criteria for entry** – Wrestlers under 18 must travel with a parent or adult guardian. The IAWA do not book flights or accommodation. All wrestlers must have a registered & Vetted IAWA Coach. All Participants must be a current IAWA members and must hold a current passport to travel to the UK (Any nation) with at least 6 months validity after the date of the competition. They must also have an appropriate visa if required by you to travel to the UK. Entries for this competition must go through the IAWA. Participants must be of a reasonable standard of

wrestling ability. Wrestling ability must be verified by an IAWA Coach. Participants must be medically fit to wrestle.

*Wrestlers and Coaches are reminded that when travelling abroad they are representing Ireland and Irish Wrestling. The only thing that is asked for in return for sponsoring wrestlers travelling to compete in these events, is that they do their best and if they are lucky enough to make it onto the podium for a medal that they wear Irish Wrestling apparel such as an IAWA branded T-shirt, hoodie or singlet. When the IAWA invest in wrestlers travelling to represent Irish wrestling, it is only fair that it gets recognised publicly.*
