Style – Free style Male and Female, Match brackets will be created based on the BWA 10% rule For age groups U11 and below girls will be paired in the FS category unless there are 3 or more that can be paired using the 10% rule.

Weight Categories Free style Male and Female Match brackets will be created based on the BWA 10% rule. For age groups U11 and below girls will be paired in the FS category unless there are 3 or more that can be paired using the 10% rule. U9, U11, U13, U15, U17, Seniors 18+

Cost – The IAWA will cover the competition fee and a percentage of the travel cost for suitable wrestlers and IAWA coaches only. This will be reimbursed after the competition and is subject to terms and conditions. Wrestlers and coaches are responsible for making their own way to and from the competition.

Criteria for entry – All Participants must be a current IAWA member and must hold a current passport to travel to the UK (Any nation) with at least 6 months validity after the date of the competition. They must also have an appropriate visa if required by you to travel to the UK. Entries for this competition must go through the IAWA. Participants must be of a reasonable standard of wrestling ability. Wrestling ability must be verified by an IAWA Coach. Participants must be medically fit to wrestle.

Wrestlers and Coaches are reminded that when travelling abroad they are representing Ireland and Irish Wrestling. The only thing that is asked for in return for sponsoring wrestlers travelling to compete in these events, is to do their best and if they are lucky enough to make it onto the podium for a medal that they wear Irish Wrestling apparel such as an IAWA branded T-shirt, hoodie or singlet. When the IAWA invest in wrestlers travelling to represent Irish wrestling, it is only fair that it gets recognised publicly.

The IAWA are constantly building their brand, it is important that as a sponsor they get recognition for the support they give to athletes. This can be done at no cost to the wrestler or club in social media posts & photos or by tagging the #irishwrestling name where possible. If Irish Wrestling Branded T-shirts, Hoodies or singlets are required, please email irishwrestlingsecretary@gmail.com with the sizes, quantities and contact details. Payment details will be sent back to you.

By signing up to take part in this competition you are also signing up to the IAWA Code of Conduct for wrestlers and Sport Ireland's Rules on Anti-Doping. The anti-doping rules of the Irish Amateur Wrestling Association are the Irish Anti-Doping Rules as agreed with WADA and as amended from time to time and the Doping Regulations promulgated by United World Wrestling.
