

RECOMMENDED ROLE DESCRIPTION: COVID-19 CLUB SAFETY OFFICER

TITLE: COVID-19 Club Safety Officer

ROLE AND PURPOSE OF POSITION:

The role of the COVID-19 Club Safety Officer is to oversee public health measures across the club. This position is expected to be a volunteer role. The person must be a current IAWA member

REPORTING RELATIONSHIPS:

Club Safety Committee Club President OR Club Chairperson

WORKING RELATIONSHIPS:

Club Members COVID-19 Club Compliance Officers COVID-19 Club Safety Committee Club President IAWA Official

KEY COMPETENCIES:

Knowledge of IAWA Return To Wrestling Guidelines For Clubs Knowledge of implementing a Health & Safety Plan Knowledge of COVID-19. Have completed the Sport Ireland Covid 19 Course online https://www.sportireland.ie/covid19/course

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Chair the COVID-19 Club Safety Committee and nominate participants to act as COVID-19 Club Compliance Officers
- Receive and review updates from COVID-19 Club Compliance officers on all club activities
- Carry out COVID-19 Club Risk Assessment and develop a COVID-19 Club Safety Plan
- Develop and deliver procedures for club members to return to Wrestling in line with forthcoming guidance from the IAWA and in line with government protocol
- Ensure the club facility, at all times, complies with COVID-19 requirements in terms of signage, equipment, hand sanitising stations, PPE etc
- Keep updated with ongoing government, health authority and IAWA advice, update procedures accordingly and communicate with members as necessary
- Develop an emergency response in line with government, health authority and IAWA advice/guidance to a suspected COVID-19 case
- Oversee COVID-19 Club Compliance officers and report to the safety committee or other appointed person regularly.

The COVID-19 Club Safety Officer shall undertake the above duties, or delegate them to a named and competent member of the Club Safety Committee.
